Whether you're seeking group study or private tuition, Italy has countless language schools. To get an idea of the types of courses available (and how much you can expect to pay), take a look at **Scuola Leonardo da Vinci** (website: www.scuolaleonardo.com). Centers in Rome, Milan, Florence, and Siena offer lessons from Monday to Friday.

A one-week intensive course of 20 lessons costs €210 (\$244). A long-term standard course (12 weeks, 240 lessons) costs €1,800 (\$2,090). All textbooks and other supplies are provided by the school, but you are expected to bring your own dictionary.
